The 'Himachal Pradesh Election Watch' is a non-partisan civil society effort at creating accountable and transparent governance in the State.

Following the Supreme Court judgment of 2 May 2002 and 13 March 2003, it is the citizens fundamental right to know the background of candidates before casting their votes.

Post- Judgment, this is the first Assembly Election in Himachal Pradesh. This election is for Eleventh Assembly in the State. The hill Women who literally is backbone of the economy in the region vis-à-vis the State have been pushed to the backseat. Hopefully, the trend should not percolate to the voting turn-out. This withdrawal is a serious threat to our Democracy, in addition to all the existing ones.

A number of Academicians, Social Activists, Intellectuals, NGOs, Youth, retired Govt. servants and the concerned Citizens have come to a platform under the banner of 'HIMACHAL PRADESH ELECTION WATCH'.

The HPEW has collected the affidavits filed by candidates along with their nomination papers and collated them for better comprehension of the voter. Details of our findings were released to the Media and other Civil Society organizations on 12 December 2007.

We solicit your cooperation in disseminating candidate background information so that the Voters are enabled to make an informed choice.

For the purpose of Records a Detailed Report shall be published later.

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सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने अपने 2 मई 2002 एवं 13 मार्च 2003 के फैसले में प्रत्येक उम्मीदवार को एक हलफ़नामे द्वारा अपने अपराधिक रिकार्ड (यदि कोई है तो), वित्तीय, और शैक्षणिक जानकारी देने के लिये बाध्य कर, मतदाता और नागरिकों को देश के राजनीतिक तंत्र में सुधार लाने में अपनी सक्रिय भूमिका अदा करने हेतु सक्षम बना दिया है।

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The Supreme Court judgments of 2 May 2002 and 13 March 2003 mandating disclosure of criminal records (if any), financial and educational information by all candidates has empowered the Voter and the Civil Society to actively participate in improving the quality of polity and governance in our country.

The **H.P. Election Watch** (HPEW) is a non-partisan civil society effort at creating accountable and transparent governance in the State. It is not aligned to any political party/ candidate. Main objective is to raise voter awareness to enable them make an informed choice before casting their vote. In particular, the entire effort is directed to ensure that the political parties put up public service oriented, capable and honest candidates.

The report is based on information collected from affidavits of all the 336 candidates, contesting elections to the H.P. Assembly 2007.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Out of the total 336 candidates

- **50** (**15** %) candidates have criminal cases pending against them. Of these 39 are charged with wrongful restraint/ confinement, 15 with criminal intimidation, 13 with cheating and forgery. In this category top three are BJP 25/68 (37%), CPI/CPM 6/15 (40%) and SP 1/10 (10%).
- In all 171 (51 %) candidates either do not have PAN or they have been reluctant in mention it in their affidavits. Among major political parties NCP leads the list with 100%, CPI/CPM 80%, LJP 77 %, SP 70% and BSP 55%.
- In all **51 candidates have declared assets worth more than Rs.1 Crore**. INC leads the category with 27/67 (40 %), followed by BJP 13/68 (19 %) and BSP 5/67 (7 %).
- Among the major political parties, **average declared assets** of INC candidate are worth Rs.302.05 Lakh, BJP 71.31 Lakh, and BSP 39.32 Lakh.

ADR (Association for Democratic Reforms), Lok Kalyan Mandal, and more than 14 NGOs and Social activists have collectively worked for 'H.P. Election Watch' to bring out this Report.



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
